


Imatinib plasma level determination

Sending samples

GJI

- 1) Blood to be drawn using a heparinized vial **JUST BEFORE IMATINIB DELIVERY**, generally $24h \pm 3h$ (or $12h \pm 1.5h$ if 2 deliveries/day) following the last delivery.
 - 2) The plasma should be sent at ambient temperature (below 30°C).
 - 3) Place the **samples** and the **filled out “Imatinib Monitoring Request”** form in a shipping container for diagnostic specimens (UN 3373).
 - 4) Affix on the outside of the packaging the specific **shipping document***
 - 5) To arrange collection by DHL (*phone before 12pm for collection in the afternoon*):
 **dhl.com to obtain your local number**, and to be put through to an adviser
